

Attached is a requisition from Mr. Superintendent Garrard for sports equipment for the above mentioned school.

Inspector Davey has reviewed this requisition and recommends that the purchase of this equipment be authorized with the exception of the last 5 items marked in red.

It is realized that the Department does not normally supply boxing equipment but it is felt that an exception might be made in this case inasmuch as the playing facilities at Alberni are restricted and the school has already equipped an old shed for this sport. Teams from the school are regularly entered into competition with white groups in the town of Alberni.



We are publishing a note in the next issue of the Bulletin directing that these not be used in Indian schools. As yours is the first to mention them, I presume that other schools did not write to the Embassy in Washington, D.C.

Normally, we check carefully all the pamphlets and bulletins recommended in the Bulletin. In this case, we assumed that a list given to summer school students at Macdonald Teachers' College would be above reproach. This incident has shown that such lists will also have to be carefully checked. I am passing these bulletins to the proper authorities for further action.


