INDIAN AFFAIRS

The Board had under consideration a memorandum from the Honourable the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs reporting that when tenders were called for to paint the buildings of the Sandy Bay Indian Residential School in the Portage la Prairie Indian agency, Province of Manitoba, the following were received:

G.R. Rogers, Portage la Prairie,.....	\$2,050.00.
Geo. Garnier, Portage la Prairie,.....	1,975.00.
E.L. Bouveron, Winnipeg,.....	1,965.00.
Thomas Curtis, Portage la Prairie,.....	1,955.00.

In view of the fact that the lowest tender submitted, that of Thomas Curtis for \$1,955.00, is incomplete, in that it does not quote on all the work required to be done, the Superintendent General recommends, pursuant to the requirements of Sub-Section 2 of Section 35 of the Public Works Act, that the contract be awarded to the next lowest tenderer, E.L. Bouveron, for the amount of his tender as above cited, namely, \$1,965.00, money being available from the Vote for Indian Education, No.279.

The Board concur in the above recommendation and submit the same for favourable consideration.
