Dear Sir:

We are endeavouring to place display samples of Eastern Indian handicraft, which is available commercially, in the various national parks as a means of assisting in marketing the goods for the Indians concerned.

Mr. B. I. Love, Superintendent of the Elk Island National Park, Lamont, Alberta, has written advising us that he has arranged space in their Golf-Course Club House for a case of the following dimensions: height $7\frac{1}{2}$ ft., width $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft., and depth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. The case is to be placed in a room in which the wood-work is painted white. As we have not funds available from which to supply an ordinary showcase, it has occurred to me that we might take advantage of this opportunity to call attention to the skill of the boys in the manual training class of Kamloops Indian Residential School. I think it would be well to have the case made in two sections, and enclose a drawing with the suggested outline, which you might discuss with the manual training instructor. You will see in the specifications that it is necessary to arrange for moveable shelves, as the baskets to be displayed are different heights and sizes.

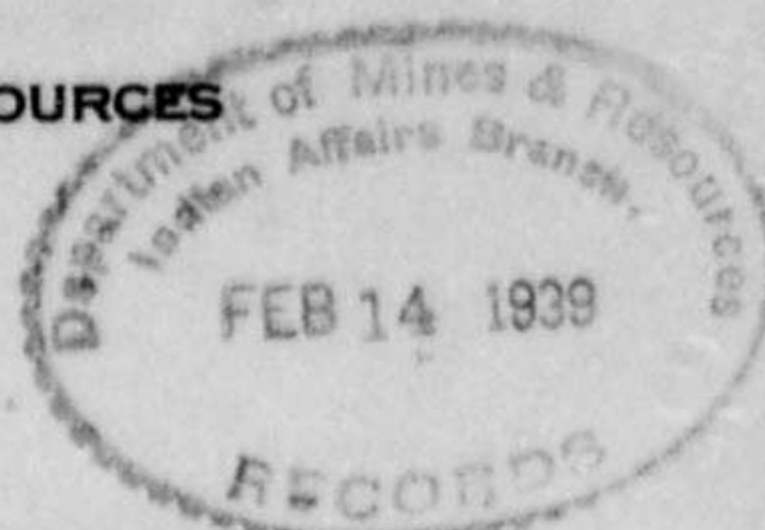

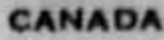
