Dear Sir:

I would advise that Rev. O. B. Strapp, Principal of Mt. Elgin School, has informed me that some repair work and painting is urgently needed in the primary classroom in the annex building of the school. On inspection of the room I found that the plaster on the ceiling has cracked in many places and small portions of it have already fallen off. If this is not repaired it will be a menace to the pupils in the room and I would recommend that the classroom be repaired as soon as possible.

The ceiling of the classroom is 32 ft. long and 25 ft. wide and Mr. Strapp and I agree that it should be covered with Tentest material instead of plaster. It would take 800 ft. of Tentest $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick at an estimated cost of \$44.00 plus 288 lineal ft. of $1\frac{3}{4}$ " lattice stripping at a cost of \$4.32. The labour in putting on the Tentest would be approximately \$20.00 making a total estimated expenditure of \$68.32.

Walls of this classroom need painting as do the ceilings in all five rooms of the northern end of second-floor apartment in the annex building. About seven gallons of paint costing \$31.50 would be necessary. Two gallons of turpentine, one gallon of boiled oil and three pounds of ordinary glue to fill in the cracks in the plaster on the walls before painting would be necessary. It would require about four gallons of grey spray paint for the ceilings of the apartment rooms and three gallons of buff paint for the walls of the classroom. According to the Principal, this painting could be done with a spray gun by the pupils of the school and no labour costs in painting would be involved.

The total estimated cost of the materials for the above would be \$84.00 and labour in putting on the Tentest would be \$20.00.

I would recommend that authority be granted to purchase the materials locally so that there will be no delay and the repairs effected before school reopens on Sept. 1st. Suitable Indian labour is very scarce now and I would wish authority to employ white labour to put on the Tentest if Indians cannot be obtained to do the work which is very doubtful at the present time. Payment of labour and materials would be made by voucher from the Department if the expenditure is approved.

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

Dear Sir:

Enclosed please find triplicate copies of credit voucher No. 257 amounting to \$50.00 in favour of the Caradoc Indian Agency Trust Account, Muncey, Ontario, and being for wages paid in repairing the drain at Mount Elgin Indian Residential School.

This money was paid from accountable cheque # 33265 for \$75.00 advanced by the Department under authority of your letter 7-0-5 of May 19th, 1941, and leaves an unexpended balance of \$25.00 which will be returned to the Department with Receiver General returns for the end of August, 1941.

Anderson Kennedy, an Indian of this Agency who is experienced in work of this nature, was engaged to do the repair work on this drain which cost less than the estimated expenditure of \$75.00. Repair work as outlined in Mr. Moore's letter of May 13th was done and the drain appears to be in proper condition for future use.

Dear Sir:

Enclosed please find vouchers to a total of \$21.00 being payment of wages for labour in putting TenTest on the ceiling of the kindergarten primary room in the annex building at the Mount Elgin Indian Residential School at Caradoc Agency.

This work has been completed by two Indians of this Agency. Asa Bunn is more or less experienced in work of this kind and he acted as foreman on the job and was paid at the rate of forty cents per hour whereas his helper, Edward Walker, was engaged at the rate of thirty cents an hour. A very satisfactory job was done by these two Indians and I would recommend payment of the enclosed vouchers which exceeds the estimate for labour by the amount of one dollar.

The work at this room at the School was performed under authority of your letter 7-0-5 of August 14th, 1941.

The account for materials used will be forwarded to the Department when it has been received at this office.
