I am informed by the Principal that the covering appeared rather light when this lot arrived and they were all re-covered with heavy grade ticking but apart from that they have no complaint and at present the filling appears to be as good as new.

The mattresses which require replacing at this time have been in use since the school was opened in 1929.

RE: REFRIGERATION REPAIRS.

Dear Sir:

I am enclosing herewith ~~four~~ ^{two} copies of an Invoice handed to me by Mr. Art Cheyne.

The large "Walk-in" Kelvinator broke down last winter. It developed a strong leak in the gas line. We called in Mr. Cheyne, expecting only a small job, such as we have taken care of in the past, and paid out of our grant, under "Buildings & Repairs".

I asked Mr. Cheyne for an estimate. He would only give this after he had taken possession of the faulty part. His estimate was for \$84.00. I told him that was out of the question and sent the part into the Kelvinator Company, Winnipeg. They had the job welded, and charged us \$4.50.

The part was returned but after assembling was found to be still faulty. Kelvinator of Winnipeg re-welded, without charge.

Mr. Cheyne reassembled the Condenser for us. After considerable dissatisfaction we called him in again. This time he repaired and adjusted the line strainer.

After considerable urging, he handed in his Bill in the present form. The amount was higher than originally expected, but probably not in excess for the skilled type of work and the number of trips involved.

However, it was sufficiently high that I would request the Departments earnest consideration in reimbursing the school for this payment. Our chequ was A-259 of June 7th. 1943, for \$42.80.

Extract from Indian Agent Paterson's report for the month of July, 1943, on the Kenora Indian Agency.

Schools

Closed for summer vacation. Called on several occasions to Cecilia Jeffrey I.R. School to check on water system. On July 5th was called by Miss Carruthers advising that school water system had broken down - sent Mr. J.G. Brown, Local Plumber, to check over. Pumps were not able to draw water, and at request of school engineer, I ordered set of valve discs and belt from Canadian Fairbanks, Morse Co., Winnipeg. Called at school with Mr. Brown next day and with school engineer was able to fill tank by manual control. The electric automatic cut off is beyond repair and we were advised by Williams Hardware Co. that it was possible to get a better unit to replace this at less cost than to try and repair old one. Williams Hardware Co. is to submit specifications and price of this new unit. There is great danger that the health of the staff and children may be affected if this condition is not rectified as soon as possible.

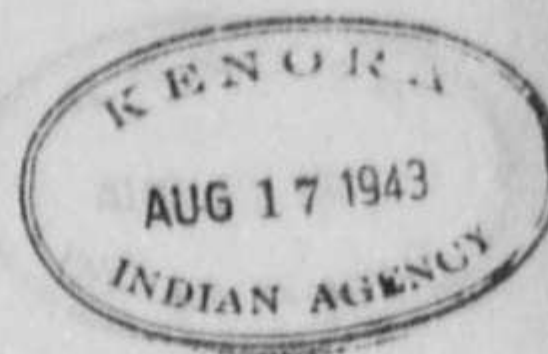

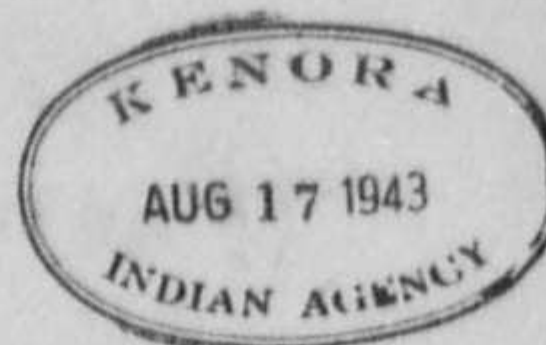

Closed for summer vacation. Called on several occasions to Cecilia Jeffrey I.R. School to check on water system. On July 5th was called by Miss Carruthers advising that school water system had broken down - sent Mr. J.G. Brown Local Plumber to check over. Pumps were not able to draw water, and at request of school engineer, I ordered sent of valve discs and Belt from Canadian Fairbanks , Morse Co. Winnipeg. Called at school with Mr. Brown next day and with school Engineer was able to fill tank by manual control. The electric authomatic cut off is beyond repair and we were advised by Williams Hardware Co. that it was possible to get a better unit to replace this at less cost than to try and repair old one. Williams Hardware Co. is to submit specifications & price of this new unit. There is great danger that the health of the staff and children may be affected if this condition is not rectified as soon as possible.
