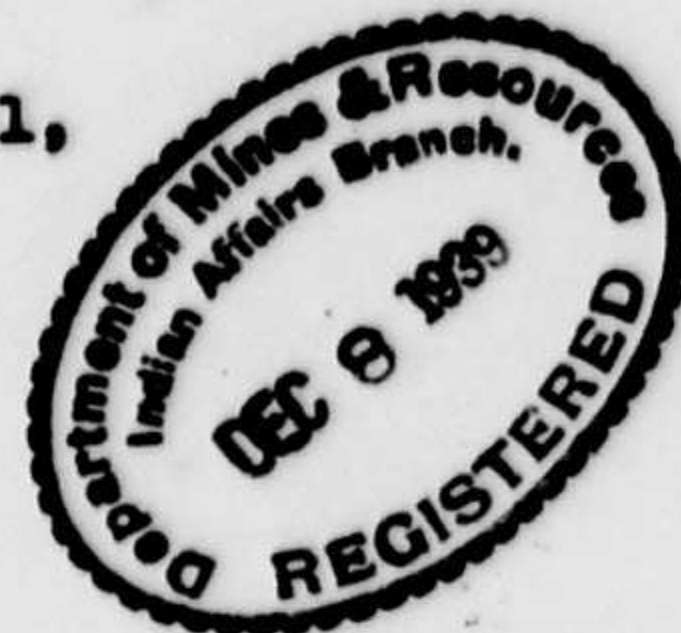

MacInnis, on Saturday, December 2nd. Every  
child in the school was examined, and we are

a total of 49 fillings, 95 extractions, and  
six who had from five to eight extractions each.

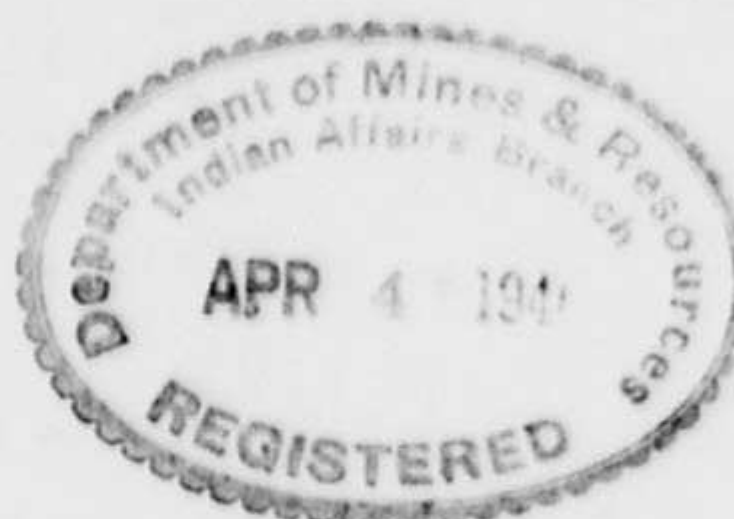
